

Class 2 Curriculum - Summer A - Term 1 - 2023

Maths

Year 1

Multiplication and division

Children will count in 2s, 5s and 10s as well as double numbers to 20. They will recognise what an equal group is, add equal groups and make arrays. They will look at making equal groups by grouping and sharing.

Fractions

Children will recognise and find halves and quarters of objects, shapes and quantities within 20.

Year 2 Fractions

Children will recognise and find halves, quarters, three quarters and thirds. The will learn about unit and non-unit fractions of shapes and quantities.

<u>Time</u>

Children will learn how to read o' clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. They will tell the time past the hour and to the hour in 5-minute intervals.

Computing - Word Processing

Children will be taught basic typing and word processing skills. They will learn how to type with two hands, use the shift, space and enter key properly and edit work by using the backspace, delete and arrow keys. Children will then go on to learn how to use undo and redo and how to select and format text.

Music

Children will learn about combining pulse, rhythm and pitch within songs and music. They will learn to sing songs and play notes on the Glockenspiel.

English

★ Character Description

Children will create a description of Captain Cook describing his appearance and personality.

★ Story Writing

Children will write a story about Captain Cook with a descriptive setting, speech and paragraphs. They will also use lots of ambitious adjectives.

* Recount

Children will write a recount after our visit to Captain Cook Birthplace Museum.



History

This term we will be learning all about the famous explorer Captain Cook. Children will find out about his life and how he voyaged around the world to discover new lands. They will visit the Captain Cook Birthplace Museum to take part in a range of activities to see what life might have been like onboard HMB Endeavour. Children will look at different sources of evidence and decide what they tell us about Captain Cook. We will also take a closer look at Australia and compare it to the UK.

<u>Art</u>

Children will be exploring line, tone/form, texture and colour to create drawings of Australian wildlife like those found during Captain Cook's voyages.

Science - Plants

Children will look at the features of seeds and plants and the structure of common plants. They will explore their local environment to discover which plants and trees grow in gardens and which ones grown in the wild. Children will learn how to grow a plant from a seed and what is needed to ensure it stays alive. They will also compare fruit and vegetable plants.

RE - Hinduism

Children will learn about Hindus' beliefs about God. They will learn about worship at the Mandir and in the home as well as the significance of a shrine and a Puja tray. They will also learn about the festival of Raksha Bandhan where families celebrate their love for each other.

PSHE - Growing Up

Children will learn how we grow and change, both physically and emotionally. They will learn about their own and others' bodies, gender stereotypes and different types of families. They will also learn about respecting their own and others' bodies, keeping their bodies safe and sharing their feelings in response to life experiences.

<u>PE</u>

Children will have two PE lessons a week.

Cricket

Children will learn how to hit a ball with a bat; track and retrieve a ball; and throw and catch a ball.

Athletics

Children will begin to link running and jumping; refine their running technique including pathways and speeds; and develop throwing techniques to send objects over long distances.
