Key Stage 2 SATS

This year, KS2 assessment tests (SATS) for year 6 children will take place week beginning Monday 13th May 2024. **Children must not be absent during the assessment week.**

Accident emails

If your child has an accident during the school day, a member of staff will complete an online accident report and this will be emailed to the first contact email address held on file for you. If your child has a bumped head, we will endeavour to contact you before the end of the school day and you will also receive an email. Emails will come from an Evolve email address.

Notification of Wraparound price increase

The cost of our wraparound provision for children who are in Nursery but stay for a paid session will increase from 1st April 2024. The cost is currently £14.40 (£11.87 session & £2.53 lunch) and will now rise to £15.00 (£12.47 session & £2.53 lunch).

Private Road opposite the school

If you drive up the private road opposite the school when dropping off or collecting, please drive carefully and keep your speed to a minimum. We have had several reports of cars being driven erratically and at speed. When bringing children to school, please ensure you use the pedestrian footpath outside of the school grounds – do not cut across the car park. Children should not be in the car park as there are moving vehicles and delivery vans which could pose a risk to life.

Reading at Greatham

Research suggests that children who read regularly outside of school perform significantly better so your support at home is essential to ensure that your child makes the progress they are capable of. You can help your child by listening to them daily for about 15 minutes. To help us track how much reading your child is doing at home, it is important that you sign their reading record every time you have listened to them read. We want to work together with you to ensure your child achieves their potential as a reader. If you require any further guidance regarding reading, please ask your child's class teacher. Thank you for your continued support and happy reading!

Attendance

Attendance and punctuality are really important. Research shows those children who attend school on time and every day are far more likely to achieve their maximum potential. Please remember the school gates open at 8.40am with lessons starting at 8.45am. Gates close at 8.50am. If your child arrives after this time, they will receive a late mark. **We monitor children who are regularly late to school because our children have told us that they do not like being late.**
