	specialist teacher have taken place and areas for development have been fed back to staff.
How has your school's spending improved swimming attainment?	11/13 85% children can swim 25 metres or more.
How has your school's spending improved water safety awareness?	All children in Y3/4 attend swimming lessons for 2 years. Lower KS2 children attended a swim safe session swimming in the North Sea which promoted water safety awareness. Top up sessions include swim safe sessions. Children in Y5/6 attend top up swimming lessons with a focus on swim safe.
