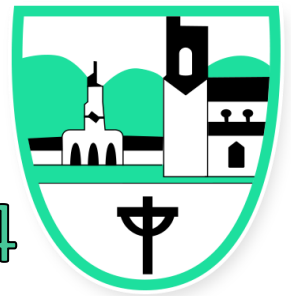

Homework

Homework

Homework will be sent out at the beginning of the half term and will include two tasks. The first a research activity and the second a creative task, both based on the topic. Details of when this should be handed in will be posted on Seesaw.

Reading

Reading at home is extremely important! Children should read three times a week and at least one of these sessions must be on Bug Club, where they must answer the comprehension questions too. Children may choose an age-appropriate book from school or home for the other two sessions. We recognise readers who have read more than three times a week in our celebration worship.

Spellings

We will send a new set of spellings every week for your child to learn based on what they have been doing in school. If you could practise these with your children, we would greatly appreciate it. The children will be tested on these spellings every Thursday.

Maths

Children should continue to practise times tables to ensure they are fluent in times table facts up to 12 x, as well as related division facts.
